RCC users read live, real-time captions through a web browser on any internet-connected computer or mobile device. The captions are provided by the same high-quality captioners who make television shows accessible. Some RCC features are:

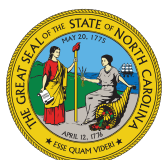
- Live captioners for better accuracy
- Adjustable captions for different font sizes, styles, and colors
- Captioner ability to read aloud RCC users’ typed responses
- Supports multiple video platforms
- Embedded captions on some video platforms available
- Save, download, or print RCC transcript
